The meeting was called to order by Mayor Burns. A motion was made by Commissioner Warren to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Hickerson, and carried unanimously.

USDA 40K Fire Hall Grant Resolution

A motion was made by Commissioner Pickett to pass the Resolution accepting the USDA Rural Development Community Facility Grant. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren, and carried unanimously.

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Drug & Alcohol Testing Policy Resolution

A motion was made by Commissioner Warren to pass the Resolution Adopting and Updated Drug and Alcohol Testing Policy. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Packwood, and carried unanimously.

E911 Lease of City Property

A motion was made by Vice Mayor Hickerson to approve the lease between the City of Clifton, and E911 for a 30x30 ft. section of property. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Pickett, and carried unanimously.

Resolution for Street Closings for Horseshoe Riverbend Festival

A motion was made by Vice Mayor Hickerson to pass the Resolution authorizing street closures and extending the noise ordinance for the Annual Horseshoe Riverbend Festival. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren, and carried unanimously.

Transportation Alternatives Project

There was a discussion concerning the proposed Transportation Alternatives Project to install a sidewalk from the Clifton Marina to the 4-way stop on Pillow Street. Ms. Davina Gurschick with Community Development Partners, and Mr. Randy McKennon with TLM Associates Engineering gave the commissioners information on the proposed project, and grant information. A motion was made by Commissioner Packwood to spend the \$100,000.00 that is budgeted for the project (let this go as far as it will go), and then apply for a grant.
